



2019 International Diabetes Camping Conference Poster Guidelines

DECA invites poster presentations that communicate concepts and data relevant to diabetes camping. (Education Programs, Activities, Outcome Studies, Medical Protocols, etc.) Posters can utilize a combination of visuals (pictures, graphics, charts, diagrams, etc.) and text. An example is available at [Conference Poster Example](#). All posters will be on display in the meeting area on Sunday and Monday. Attendees can engage in one-on-one conversations with the author(s) and ask questions about their project or findings at a designated time. Poster submission deadline is January 10th with notification regarding acceptance made via email by January 30th.

In order to present your poster, you must register as an attendee. Poster presenters are responsible for their registration, lodging and travel expenses. Information about registration and the conference hotel can be accessed at [DECA 2019 Conference](#).

Poster Information

1. Authors/presenters are responsible for the shipping costs/transportation of their poster.
2. Poster size should be 36" tall by 60" wide.
3. Poster set-up time is on Sunday, February 17th from 8:00 am – 1:00 pm in the general session meeting room.
4. Poster removal is Monday, February 18th from 5:00 pm – 6:00 pm. Posters remaining after 6:00 pm will be discarded. DECA does not accept responsibility for discarded posters.

Poster Guidelines

1. Title at top of poster
2. Author(s) and affiliations
3. Arrange poster in a neat and orderly manner
4. Simple readable fonts to be used, such as Arial, Times New Roman, Tahoma, etc. Avoid all uppercase letters for subheadings or text. Use a dark color for text for readability.
5. Industry (pharmaceutical device or drug manufacturer) logos are NOT allowed to appear on the poster.
6. No materials/attachments should extend beyond the perimeters of the poster.
7. Keep charts/drawings/illustrations simple as posters are viewed beyond the regular reading distances of a handout.
8. Poster should be self-explanatory, supplementary handouts if needed, must be provided by the author(s).
9. Brand names/company logos/service promotions are not allowed.
10. Save in PDF format. Provide a copy to DECA.

Suggested Components for Posters Reporting on Research & Studies

1. Background/Introduction
2. Research Hypothesis, Purpose, or Objective
3. Study/Design Methods
4. Results
5. Conclusion/Implications and implementation suggestions
6. References
7. Acknowledgments
